



1. The name Tod was also listed as Todt during the first World War (his military "unit" did not want someone named "Dead" in the outfit)

2. August Schäfer's profession was listed as a Feilenhauer (a person that reconditions used files) on Minna's birth notice from the Diemarden Protestant Church. It also states they live in Diemarden.

3. According to Rita: sister Alwine (born 1893) died at 18 years as a consequence of a "back-street" abortion

4. According to Rita: Amahlie Tod was never married. She was the long time housemaid for a cavalry captain. He is the father of the children.

Notes

a: most dates are written using the English (US) naming convention: month-day-year except the ones using periods: day.month.year

b: all maiden names are in "()". "(?)" means we do have the maiden name.

c: a "?" means we know a person exists but do not have any more information.
